**Confit duck** crispy skin duck breast, apple spiced braised red cabbage, grand manier blood orange (GF)

**Eye fillet** three peppercorn xo gravy, escarola, truffle potato (GF)

**Sea bream** eastern coast bream, butter and herb pan seared, grenobloise, warm honey baked dutch carrots, semi dried baby roma, parsnip puree (GF)

**Orrechiete** lancefield providore broccoli, zucchini and hazelnut pesto, 18 month aged parmigiano Reggiano (VG VO)
